

## Spelling list: Some *ch* words

The usual way to spell the sound /ch/ is with the letters *ch* .

chain	There was a broken link in the <b>chain</b> .
charm	I bought a <b>charm</b> for my <b>charm</b> bracelet.
chat	Do you have time for a quick <b>chat</b> ?
cheese	The <b>cheese</b> was very crumbly.
cherry	Each cake was topped with a <b>cherry</b> .
chess	The boy was unbeaten in <b>chess</b> .
chicken	They had <b>chicken</b> for lunch.
children	The <b>children</b> sat in rows.
chop	Could you <b>chop</b> some wood for the fire?
choose	We need to <b>choose</b> a new leader.
church	It was very quiet in the <b>church</b> .
bench	They sat together on the park <b>bench</b> .
bunch	He bought me a huge <b>bunch</b> of flowers.
coach	They went by <b>coach</b> to the beach.
lunch	He had some pasta for <b>lunch</b> .
march	<b>March</b> is the third month of the year.
speech	This is the first draft of my <b>speech</b> .
teacher	The <b>teacher</b> gave me good advice.
torch	You will need a <b>torch</b> to see in the dark.
