Nature, Plants

bark	<b>Bark</b> is the tough protective covering of the woody stems and roots of trees and other woody plants.
branch	A <b>branch</b> is a division of a stem, or secondary stem arising from the main stem of a plant.
bush	A <b>bush</b> is a low woody perennial plant that usually has several major stems.
flower	A <b>flower</b> is a plant cultivated for its blooms or blossoms.
grass	<b>Grass</b> is a green herbage that is grown as lawns and used as pasture for grazing animals.
leaf	A <b>leaf</b> is the main organ of photosynthesis and transpiration in higher plants.
nature	<b>Nature</b> is the natural physical world including plants, animals, and landscapes.
plant	A <b>plant</b> is a living organism lacking the power of locomotion.
seed	A <b>seed</b> is something that is sowed in order to grow a plant.
thorn	A <b>thorn</b> is a small sharp-pointed tip resembling a spike on a stem or leaf.
sprout	A <b>sprout</b> is a newly grown bud.
tree	A <b>tree</b> is a tall perennial woody plant having a main trunk and branches forming a distinct elevated crown.
weed	A <b>weed</b> is a plant that crowds out cultivated plants.
