cold	A <b>cold</b> is a a mild viral infection involving the nose and respiratory passages.
cancer	<b>Cancer</b> is a malignant growth or tumor caused by abnormal and uncontrolled cell division.
fever	A <b>fever</b> is a rise in the temperature of the body.
flu	<b>Flu</b> is an acute febrile highly contagious viral disease.
germ	A <b>germ</b> is a bacterium that causes disease.
headache	A <b>headache</b> is a pain in the head.
health	<b>Health</b> refers to the general condition of the body and mind.
heart	The <b>heart</b> is a muscle which contracts to move the blood through the body.
attack	A heart <b>attack</b> is a sudden severe instance of abnormal heart function.
medicine	<b>Medicine</b> is something that treats, prevents, or alleviates the symptoms of disease.
sick	Someone who is <b>sick</b> is affected by an impairment of normal physical or mental function.
sore	If something is <b>sore</b> , it is causing pain or distress.
throat	A sore <b>throat</b> is an inflammation of the fauces and pharynx.
symptom	A <b>symptom</b> is a sensation or change in bodily function that is experienced by a patient and is associated with a particular disease.
disease	A <b>disease</b> is an impairment of health or a condition of abnormal functioning.
unwell	Someone who is <b>unwell</b> is affected by an impairment of normal physical or mental function.
