barber	A barber is a hairdresser who cuts hair and shaves beards as a trade.
blacksmith	A blacksmith works with metals in a forge.
bodyguard	A bodyguard is someone who escorts and protects a prominent person.
carpenter	A carpenter is a woodworker who makes or repairs wooden objects.
coach	A coach is someone in charge of training an athlete or a team.
electrician	An electrician is a person who installs or repairs electrical or telephone lines.
farmer	A farmer is someone who operates a farm.
firefighter	A firefighter is a member of a fire department who tries to extinguish fires.
fisherman	A fisherman is someone whose occupation is catching fish.
guard	A guard is a person who keeps watch over something or someone.
guide	A guide is someone who shows the way by leading or advising.
hairdresser	A hairdresser is someone who cuts or beautifies hair.
janitor	A janitor is someone employed to clean and maintain a building.
masseuse	A masseuse is a female massager.
mechanic	A mechanic is someone whose occupation is repairing and maintaining automobiles.
notary	A notary is someone legally empowered to witness signatures and certify a document's validity and to take depositions.
	A plumber is a craftsman who installs and repairs pipes and fixtures and

plumber	appliances.
police	The police are a civil force responsible for the detection and prevention of crime.
postman	A postman is a man who delivers the mail.
repairman	A repairman is a skilled worker whose job is to repair things.
