

Spelling list: *are* - longer words

In this list, you'll explore longer words that use the letters *are* to spell the /air/ sound. These words follow the same pattern as the shorter ones but can be a bit more challenging. Examples include *aware* , *prepare* , and *nightmare* . Whether you're *aware* of something, *preparing* for an exam, or recalling a bad *nightmare* , these words are useful in both writing and speech.

warfare	Modern warfare uses computers.
welfare	I care about the welfare of badly treated horses.

glassware	Glassware must be packed very carefully.
ovenware	Ovenware must be able to stand a high heat.
silverware	The table was laid with fine silverware .
