

## Spelling list: -ore words

If the sound /or/ is on the end of a word, it is usually spelled with the letters -ore . Some common examples include *shore* , *core* , and *store* . This spelling pattern helps distinguish these words from others that use *or* , *aw* , or *au* for the same sound. Learning this pattern will help improve spelling accuracy. Regular practice with spelling activities will reinforce your recognition of -ore words and their correct usage in writing.

ore                    They mined for **ore** .

bore                    He was a **bore** .

core                    Peel the apple and cut out the **core** .

gore                    This horror movie is full of blood and **gore** .

more                    I need to get some **more** sleep.

chore                    She made a **chore** chart for her children.

score                    The teacher calculated the average test **score** for the class.

shore                    We searched for shells along the **shore** .

snore                    Shaun snores very loudly.

sore                    I keep sneezing and my throat is **sore** .

store                    I am taking my broken laptop back to the **store** .

tore                    I **tore** my skirt on a nail.
