

## Spelling list: *or* - longer words

The sound /or/ is most commonly spelled with the same letters as the word: *or* .

corner	Meet me at the <b>corner</b> of the street.
border	That photo would look better with a <b>border</b> .
orchard	We have apple and plum trees in our <b>orchard</b> .
glory	The old house is being restored to its former <b>glory</b> .
normal	My <b>normal</b> working hours are eight until five.
forty	I estimate we'll land in <b>forty</b> minutes.
formal	It's a <b>formal</b> dinner so we need to dress smartly.
forbid	Mum said 'If you do that again I will <b>forbid</b> you to watch TV'.
fortune	He made his <b>fortune</b> on the Internet.
fortunate	I was <b>fortunate</b> to win the prize.
inform	Please <b>inform</b> me when my order is ready to collect.
transform	A new coat of paint will <b>transform</b> this room.
uniform	The Air Force <b>uniform</b> is blue.
import	It is against the law to <b>import</b> fresh meat.
export	These cars are to be sold for <b>export</b> .
report	Please email me a copy of your <b>report</b> .
transport	After the car crash he had no <b>transport</b> .
tornado	Was the damage caused by a <b>tornado</b> ?
tortoise	A <b>tortoise</b> is a slow moving reptile with a hard shell.
