

## Spelling list: *ou* words - set 1

The sound /ou/ as in *out*, at the beginning or in the middle of a word, is often spelled with the letters *ou*. The only two cases where the *ou* sound is spelled with the letters *ou* at the end of the word are *thou* and *miaou*. This list looks at a few *ou* words.

loud	The baby gave a <b>loud</b> wail.
proud	Dad was very <b>proud</b> when I won first prize.
shroud	A <b>shroud</b> is cloth used to wrap a body.
noun	A <b>noun</b> is a word that names someone or something.
sour	Lemons have a <b>sour</b> taste.
scour	We will <b>scour</b> the county until we find this criminal.
scout	He went to <b>scout</b> out a spot for dinner.
shout	He had to <b>shout</b> before he was heard.
spout	The old jug has a chipped <b>spout</b> .
sprout	The plants began to <b>sprout</b> leaves.
stout	The man was described as short and <b>stout</b> .
bound	He's <b>bound</b> to want to come to the party.
found	I <b>found</b> my lost book.
ground	The earthquake made the <b>ground</b> shake.
hound	The fox and the <b>hound</b> were best friends.
mound	A <b>mound</b> is a small hill.
pound	I have one <b>pound</b> coin in my money box.
round	I'll come <b>round</b> to your house.
