

Spelling list: Words ending in *-ice*

On the end of a word of more than one syllable the /iss/ sound is usually spelled *ice* .

bodice	The bodice of her wedding dress fits perfectly.
hospice	We are raising funds to build a new hospice .
justice	The killer will be brought to justice .
lattice	Ivy grew up the lattice fence.
malice	I did not feel any malice towards her.
novice	I am a complete novice at the game of darts.
office	I'll call your office to say you are sick.
practice	He tried to put his new maths skills into practice , but still needed a calculator to work out the final sum.
service	Call room service to order breakfast.
solstice	The summer solstice is the longest day of the year.
accomplice	The criminal and his accomplice were jailed.
apprentice	The plumbing company employed Jim as an apprentice .
precipice	She felt like she was standing at the edge of a precipice .
prejudice	The article exposes the company's deep-rooted prejudice against women.
