After the letter *l* many words use *ar* to spell the weak vowel ending.

polar	<b>Polar</b> bears are adapted to live in a cold environment.
scholar	She was a <b>scholar</b> at Oxford.
solar	The energy used in this house is from the <b>solar</b> panels.
muscular	The athlete was very <b>muscular</b> .
particular	I like that dress in <b>particular</b> .
popular	Walking is a <b>popular</b> form of exercise.
rectangular	A shoe box is <b>rectangular</b> in shape.
regular	There is a <b>regular</b> bus to York.
spectacular	A solar eclipse is a <b>spectacular</b> sight.
triangular	The village green is <b>triangular</b> in shape.
similar	Our house is a <b>similar</b> design to yours.
