

## Spelling list: The /v/ sound after v

To spell the sound /v/ at the end of a word use *al* or *el*.

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| carnival | There were various amusements at the <b>carnival</b> .         |
| festival | We will be camping at the music <b>festival</b> .              |
| interval | There will be an <b>interval</b> halfway through the show.     |
| oval     | Dinner was served on a large <b>oval</b> plate.                |
| rival    | She was determined to beat her <b>rival</b> .                  |
| bevel    | The table edge had a slight <b>bevel</b> .                     |
| drivel   | He was talking <b>drivel</b> .                                 |
| gravel   | We used <b>gravel</b> on our driveway.                         |
| grovel   | He should be made to <b>grovel</b> at her feet.                |
| hovel    | His home is more like a <b>hovel</b> .                         |
| level    | The high <b>level</b> of noise was unbearable.                 |
| marvel   | The Grand Canyon is a natural <b>marvel</b> .                  |
| novel    | An excerpt of the <b>novel</b> was published in the newspaper. |
| shovel   | She cleared the snow with a <b>shovel</b> .                    |
| snivel   | He tried not to <b>snivel</b> but couldn't help it.            |
| swivel   | We use <b>swivel</b> chairs at work.                           |
| travel   | I <b>travel</b> to school in a car.                            |
