sibilance	Alliteration but using words beginning with 's'.
declarative	A <b>declarative</b> sentence is a sentence in the form of a statement.
imperative	An <b>imperative</b> sentence usually starts with an <b>imperative</b> verb and tells you to do something.
interrogative	An interrogative sentence ends with a question mark.
exclamative	An <b>exclamative</b> sentence ends with an exclamation mark.
rhetorical	Rhetorical question means a question that does not require an answer.
