DEVICES USED IN ENGLISH

onomatopoeia	Onomatopoeia is when it sounds like the word, for example bang.
metaphor	A metaphor is saying something is something else.
preposition	A preposition is used in a sentence to indicate the location or position of something.
synonym	A synonym is a word that means the same as another word. A synonym for 'big' is 'large'.
sibilance	Alliteration but using words beginning with 's'.
declarative	A declarative sentence is a sentence in the form of a statement.
imperative	An imperative sentence usually starts with an imperative verb and tells you to do something.
interrogative	An interrogative sentence ends with a question mark.
exclamative	An exclamative sentence ends with an exclamation mark.
rhetorical	Rhetorical question means a question that does not require an answer.
