ammeter	An <b>ammeter</b> is used to measure current in a circuit.
ampere	Current is measured in amperes.
cell	He tried to escape from the <b>cell</b> .
circuit	He's the fastest round the <b>circuit</b> .
diagram	Please see the explanatory <b>diagram</b> next to the text.
symbol	This <b>symbol</b> means 'add' : +.
conductor	The orchestra watched the <b>conductor</b> carefully.
current	The river had a strong <b>current</b> .
electric	An <b>electric</b> plug goes in a socket.
field	The sheep were let loose in the <b>field</b> .
charge	How much will you <b>charge</b> me for that?
conservation	<b>Conservation</b> of momentum is a closed system.
coulomb	The unit of charge is the <b>coulomb</b> .
insulator	A solid that does not conduct heat easily is called an <b>insulator</b> (e.g. plastic, wood).
parallel	When two objects run alongside each other but do not meet; <b>parallel</b> sound means sound that suits the scene.
resistance	With strength - amount of force a muscle can exert against <b>resistance</b> .
resistor	A <b>resistor</b> is a component in a circuit that resists the flow of electricity.
series	A <b>series</b> circuit has one path.
