buffet A **buffet** lunch will be served at noon.

cabaret There will be a **cabaret** after dinner.

chalet The skiers have rented a **chalet**.

crochet Grandma will **crochet** a shawl for the baby.

duvet This **duvet** is too warm for hot weather.

ricochet His bullet wound came from a **ricochet** .
