

Spelling list: Two syllable words - set 1

A two syllable word is a word you can split into two simple parts or beats. Each part has its own vowel sound. For instance, *robin* can be divided into *rob* and *in* .

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| robin | The robin sat on the snowy fence. |
| cabin | The cabin on the ship was very small. |
| solid | This floor is very solid . |
| habit | It is a good habit to brush your teeth before you go to bed. |
| comic | The film was full of comic moments. |
| exit | The exit is over there. |
| toxic | This fungus is toxic . |
| exam | He made a correction to his exam paper. |
