

## Spelling list: Two syllable words - set 4

Two-syllable words can be split into two distinct segments, each with its own vowel sound. For example, *cobweb* breaks into *cob* and *web* .

cobweb	I watched the spider weave a <b>cobweb</b> .
victim	The <b>victim</b> of the house fire was indebted to the firefighter.
kidnap	We read about the <b>kidnap</b> in the newspaper.
index	You will find the <b>index</b> at the back of the book.
laptop	My new <b>laptop</b> has a three year guarantee.
rapid	Some rain forests are experiencing <b>rapid</b> destruction.
topic	Do you know what <b>topic</b> we'll be covering next?
unzip	He helped his daughter <b>unzip</b> her jacket.
