

## Handwriting sheet: Precursive Arrow worksheet

Word list: *ur* - longer words

Many words in English use the letters *ur* to spell the sound /er/. This sound is common in words like *burden*, *occur*, and *turtle*. In these words, the *ur* combination is pronounced like the *er* in *her*.

Here are two examples:

*burden* – The secret was a burden on Tim's mind.

*occur* – Dreams occur when you are asleep.

These words can be tricky because of the unusual spelling, so reviewing them will help you become more confident.
