Word list: The long /oo/ sound

The spelling pattern *oo* is used to represent two slightly different sounds in English: the long /oo/ sound like in the word *soon* and the short /oo/ sound like in the word *soot*.

The examples in this list are all words that contain a long /oo/ sound. Click on the speaker icon before each word to hear how to say it or try the *Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check* spelling activity to learn how to pronounce the long /oo/ sound in these words yourself. Avoid confusion with the short /oo/ sound by paying attention to the context of the word.
