Word list: y on the end

The long /i/ sound is a vowel sound used in English. You can hear it in words like *time*, *ride*, and *cry*.

The words in this list use the letter y to spell the long /i/ sound. Notice how, in these words, the long /i/ sound falls at the end of the word. While most words that end in a long /i/ sound are spelt with the letter y, there are exceptions like *eye* and *dye*.

As there are six different ways to spell the long /i/ sound, it is important to become familiar with those that use the y spelling. Use the spelling activities to learn the long /i/ words in the list.
