

Handwriting sheet: Precursive Arrow worksheet

Word list: Long /oo/ spelled *u-e*

The split digraph *u-e* is a common way to spell the long /oo/ sound. You'll find it in words like *flute* and *rude*. This spelling follows the pattern where a *silent e* at the end of the word helps change the vowel sound in the middle of the word from short to long.

Learning to identify when *u-e* makes the long /oo/ sound will improve your spelling confidence. Try a *Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check* spelling activity with these words to help you learn them.
