- afternoon \_\_\_\_\_ is the daily event of the sun sinking below the horizon.
- daytime \_\_\_\_\_ is the time after sunset and before sunrise while it is dark outside.
- dusk \_\_\_\_\_ refers to twelve o'clock at night.
- evening \_\_\_\_\_ is the part of the day between noon and evening.
- midnight \_\_\_\_\_ is the time after sunrise and before sunset while it is light outside.
- morning \_\_\_\_\_ is the time period between dawn and noon.
- night \_\_\_\_\_ refers to twelve o'clock in the middle of the day.
- nighttime \_\_\_\_\_ is the time after sunset and before sunrise while it is dark outside.
- noon \_\_\_\_\_ is the time of day immediately following sunset.
- sunrise \_\_\_\_\_ is the period of decreasing daylight from late afternoon until nightfall.
- sunset \_\_\_\_\_ is the daily event of the sun rising above the horizon.
