- cloud \_\_\_\_\_ is air that moves with considerable force.
- fog A \_\_\_\_\_ is a violent combination of heavy wind, rain, and thunder and lightening.
- hail \_\_\_\_\_ describes an atmosphere where visibility is reduced.
- monsoon A \_\_\_\_\_ is a visible mass of water or ice particles suspended at a considerable altitude.
- rain A \_\_\_\_\_ is a seasonal wind that brings rain from the southwest in the summer.
- rainbow A \_\_\_\_\_ is an arc of coloured light in the sky caused by refraction of the sun's rays by rain.
- snow \_\_\_\_\_ is when water drops fall from the sky.
- storm \_\_\_\_\_ describes the warmth and light from the rays of the sun.
- sunshine \_\_\_\_\_ is when rain freezes into ice pellets that fall from the air.
- forecast A \_\_\_\_\_ is a tropical cyclone occurring in the western Pacific or Indian oceans.
- typhoon \_\_\_\_\_ is precipitation falling from clouds in the form of ice crystals.
- wind A \_\_\_\_\_ is a prediction of what the weather will be like.
