

Spelling list: Year 2 Summer Week 9 Spelling List

This week's spelling pattern / rule is: Common exception words with ea as /ay/ and a as /ar/ or /a/ (dialect)
Rule: The short e sound spelled "ea" shows up in many frequently used words. Often these are forms of a verb which still keeps the long e . For example: break, breaker, great, steak, bear, bugbear, forebear, pear, wear, swear, tear .
