

## Spelling list: Suffixes to words ending -fer-

when to double the letter r with prefix starting with a vowel

prefer	Kids <b>prefer</b> to wear casual clothes.
preferred	She <b>preferred</b> cake to pudding.
preferring	He stayed at home, <b>preferring</b> to read rather than cycle.
refer	I will <b>refer</b> your complaint to my boss.
referred	In his comprehension, he <b>referred</b> back to the book.
referral	She needed a <b>referral</b> to see a specialist doctor.
referring	He had to keep <b>referring</b> to his list.
preference	She had a <b>preference</b> for Chinese food.
reference	If you are stuck, use the instruction book for <b>reference</b> .
referee	The <b>referee</b> blew his whistle at the end of the game.
