

Spelling list: Words using the consonant digraphs ch

Words using the consonant digraphs ch. Letters and Sounds, Phase Three. Each of these words contains the target grapheme but no other Phase Three graphemes. This means that the Phase Three graphemes can be taught in any order.

chin	Daddy has hair on his chin .
chug	They wave as they chug past.
check	Check that the car is locked.
such	Are you capable of cooking such a large meal?
