

## Spelling list: Words using the consonant digraphs ch

Words using the consonant digraphs ch. Letters and Sounds, Phase Three. Each of these words contains the target grapheme but no other Phase Three graphemes. This means that the Phase Three graphemes can be taught in any order.

chop	Could you <b>chop</b> some wood for the fire?
chin	Daddy has hair on his <b>chin</b> .
chug	They wave as they <b>chug</b> past.
check	<b>Check</b> that the car is locked.
such	Are you capable of cooking <b>such</b> a large meal?
chip	<b>Chip</b> can also be a name.
chill	The recipe said to <b>chill</b> the salad for an hour.
much	How <b>much</b> do you weigh?
rich	The heir to his fortune will be very <b>rich</b> .
chicken	They had <b>chicken</b> for lunch.
