

Spelling list: Words using the consonant digraphs ng

Words using the consonant digraphs ng. Letters and Sounds, Phase Three. Each of these words contains the target grapheme but no other Phase Three graphemes. This means that the Phase Three graphemes can be taught in any order.

ring	The ring was encrusted with a jewel.
rang	Someone just rang the doorbell.
hang	Hang your coat on the hook.
song	We have a song thrush in our garden.
wing	A biplane has two sets of wings.
rung	He was on the bottom rung of the ladder.
king	The king wears a gold crown.

sing	Sing the first verse.
ping-pong	Ping-pong is a fast game.
