mourning	The country is in <b>mourning</b> for the loss of the Queen.
principal	A <b>principal</b> is the educator who has executive authority for a school.
principle	It is my <b>principle</b> to behave honestly.
prophet	The <b>prophet</b> said a holy man would come.
profit	The amount of sales will determine the profits.
stationary	Our train was <b>stationary</b> for over an hour.
stationery	I buy all the <b>stationery</b> for our office.
ascent	We continued our <b>ascent</b> of the mountain.
assent	He gave a strong nod of <b>assent</b> .
