| bias | Bias is a tendency to favour one side over another in an account of historical events. |
| biased | The Bayeux Tapestry is biased towards the Norman version of events as opposed to the Saxon one.. |
| tactics | Tactics are the art or science of disposing military or naval forces for battle and manoeuvring them in battle. |
| conqueror | A conqueror is someone who gains possession or control of a country by force or war. |
| baron | A baron is a feudal vassal holding his lands under a direct grant from the king. |
| soldier | A soldier is a person who serves in an army; a person engaged in military service. |
| tapestry | A tapestry is a fabric upon which coloured threads are woven by hand to produce a design, often pictorial; like the Bayeux Tapestry. |
| rebels | Rebels are people who who refuse allegiance and rise in arms against the government or ruler of their country. |
| rebellion | A rebellion is open, organized, and armed resistance to a government or ruler. |
| weapon | A weapon is any instrument or device for use in attack or defense in combat; like a sword, dagger or spear. |
| archaeology | Archaeology is the scientific study of historic or prehistoric peoples and their cultures. |
