bias	Bias is a tendency to favour one side over another in an account of historical events.
biased	The Bayeux Tapestry is biased towards the Norman version of events as opposed to the Saxon one
tactics	Tactics are the art or science of disposing military or naval forces for battle and manoeuvering them in battle.
conqueror	A conqueror is someone who gains possession or control of a country by force or war.
baron	A baron is a feudal vassal holding his lands under a direct grant from the king.
soldier	A soldier is a person who serves in an army; a person engaged in military service.
tapestry	A tapestry is a fabric upon which coloured threads are woven by hand to produce a design, often pictorial; like the Bayeux Tapestry.
rebels	Rebels are people who who refuse allegiance and rise in arms against the government or ruler of their country.
rebellion	A rebellion is open, organized, and armed resistance to a government or ruler.
weapon	A weapon is any instrument or device for use in attack or defense in combat; like a sword, dagger or spear.
archaeology	Archaeology is the scientific study of historic or prehistoric peoples and their cultures.
