General Geography vocabulary

geography	<b>Geography</b> is the study of the Earth - its land and seas, climates, peoples; what they grow and produce and how they live.
local	<b>Local</b> is to do with the area around you.
national	<b>National</b> is to do with the whole country.
International	<b>International</b> is to do with more than one country.
physical	<b>Physical</b> geography is the study of the natural things of the Earth.
environmental	<b>Environmental</b> geography is the study of places in which people live and how it affects them.
human	<b>Human</b> geography is the study of where and how people live.
geology	<b>Geology</b> is the study of the earth and how it was formed.
developed	<b>Developed</b> countries are places with a good standard of living.
third	<b>Third</b> world countries are places with a poor standard of living.
industry	<b>Industry</b> is the making of things in workshops and factories.
resources	<b>Resources</b> are things that are useful or valuable to people.
distribution	<b>Distribution</b> is how things are shared out, arranged or placed.
population	<b>Population</b> is the number of people living in a particular place.
global	<b>Global</b> means of the whole world.
