drama **Drama** is a play written for actors to perform.

Tragedy is a story or play which tells of terrible events and usually ends

Myth is a story from long ago, usually about unreal beings; often used to myth

thriller A **thriller** is an exciting or mysterious story, often about crime or spying.

farce Farce is ridiculous, over the top comedy.
