weather	<b>Weather</b> is the day to day state of the atmosphere.
climate	<b>Climate</b> is the weather of a place taken on average over many years.
precipitation	<b>Precipitation</b> is the water falling from the sky as rain, hail, sleet or snow.
evaporation	<b>Evaporation</b> is when a liquid turns to a gas.
condensation	<b>Condensation</b> is the change from a gas to a liquid or solid.
atmosphere	The <b>atmosphere</b> is the air around the Earth.
equatorial	<b>Equatorial</b> are places near to the Equator that are hot and wet throughout the year.
humidity	<b>Humidity</b> is the amount of moisture in th air.
drought	A <b>drought</b> is a long period of time with no rain.
meteorology	<b>Meteorology</b> is the study of the weather.
pressure	<b>Pressure</b> is the weight of air pressing down on the Earth's surface.
Depression	<b>Depression</b> is a large area of low pressure bringing clouds and rain.
prevailing	<b>Prevailing</b> winds are the direction from which the winds usually come.
isobar	An <b>isobar</b> is a line on a map joining places with the same atmospheric pressure.
front	A <b>front</b> is the place where warm and cold air meet.
