computer	A computer is an electronic machine that stores and brings back information and performs a huge amount of tasks.
hardware	Hardware is the solid objects used in I.T., for example, the monitor, computer or printer.
software	Computers need hardware and software .
CD-ROM	CD-ROM stands for Compact Disk Read Only Memory. It is a removable disk used to store computer data that cannot be wiped and replaced.
printer	The printer prints documents from a computer onto paper.
modem	The modem lets computers talk with each other using telephone lines.
Monitor	The Monitor is a television style screen that displays information from a computer.
scanner	A scanner is used to send an image or text into a computer that can be used or printed.
program	The program is a set of instructions that tells a computer what to do.
mouse	The mouse is a hand-held object that controls a pointer on screen. It is used instead of a keyboard to tell a computer what to do.
keyboard	The keyboard is a set of keys that looks like a typewriter. It is the main way of telling a computer what to do.
peripherals	Peripherals are the extra objects joined to a computer, for example the monitor or printer.
RAM	RAM stands for Random Access Memory where a computer stores data and programs temporarily. It is measured in Kilobytes.
