

## Spelling list: Naughty Numbers

10 Key number maths words that you may find tricky.

column	To do <b>column</b> subtraction, we line up the decimal points, on top of each other.
decimal	A <b>decimal</b> number is a number with a <b>decimal</b> point in it, like 1.5.
denominator	The bottom of a fraction is called the <b>denominator</b> .
divide	The family wanted to <b>divide</b> the money equally.
integer	The whole numbers including zero and negatives are called integers.
multiple	Twenty four is a <b>multiple</b> of six. Other multiples of six include twelve, eighteen and sixty.
numerator	Top heavy fractions have a <b>numerator</b> bigger than the denominator and can be written as mixed numbers.
positive	<b>Positive</b> numbers are the natural counting numbers and do not include zero.
ratio	We use <b>ratio</b> to compare two or more things with each other, including money, often shared unfairly.
reciprocal	The <b>reciprocal</b> of two is a half, because two times a half is one.
