To do column subtraction, we line up the decimal points, on top of each other.

A decimal number is a number with a decimal point in it, like 1.5. The bottom of a fraction is called the denominator .

Twenty four is a multiple of six. Other multiples of six include twelve, eighteen and sixty.

Top heavy fractions have a numerator bigger than the denominator and can be written as mixed numbers.

The reciprocal of two is a half, because two times a half is one.
