

Spelling list: Some practice in consonant patterns

A short vowel is usually followed by two consonants. A long vowel is usually followed by just one consonant.

fatter The **fatter** you get, the slower you can run.

later You can watch TV not now but **later**.

better **Better** late than never.

peter **Peter** would like to come too.

dinner It's fish for **dinner** tonight.

diner Jack stopped at the **diner** for a meal.

rocket The **rocket** shot up in the sky.

broken There was a **broken** link in the chain.

supper After **supper** we'll play some games.

super The **super** hero saved the day.
