

Spelling list: Words ending with K & Short Long vowel

Monosyllabic words ending in [k] (long vowels versus short vowels)

lick	Cats often lick their paws.
like	I don't like the way you said that.
clock	In the corner stood a cuckoo clock .
cloak	He wore a dark cloak .
sack	Father Christmas carries a sack of presents.
sake	For the sake of it.
tack	I need one more tack to hang up the picture frame.
take	Take a peek at the sleeping baby.
trick	It was a horrid trick to play on anyone.
trike	He travelled there on his trike .
sock	There's a hole in the heel of my sock .
soak	She had a long soak in the bath tub.
stock	All the surplus stock was given to charity.
stoke	I stoke the fire to keep it going.
lack	There is a lack of lockers in this school.
lake	There's a herd of buffalo by the lake .
rack	I dried the dishes on the rack .
spick	The house was tidy and it looks spick and span.
spike	A small sharp-pointed tip resembling a spike on a stem or leaf.
