Basic History words

artefact	An artefact is an object from the past.
opinion	An opinion is what someone thinks about something.
fact	A fact is when something is known to be true.
bias	Bias is to believe in your own opinion only.
evidence	Evidence are clues from the past.
past	Past is when something has already happened.
present	The present is when something is happening now.
future	The future is things that are yet to happen.
decade	A decade is a period of ten years.
century	A century is a period of 100 years.
ERA	An ERA is a period of time marked by certain events and ways of living.
decline	Decline means to come to an end or lose importance.
chronological	Chronological are events listed in the order they happen.
primary	A primary source is a first-hand piece of evidence, eg a Roman coin.
secondary	A secondary source is a piece of evidence about the past but not from the time, eg a history textbook.
