archaeology	<b>Archaeology</b> is learning about people from long ago by digging up and studying objects from the past.
events	<b>Events</b> are when something important happens.
myth	A <b>myth</b> is a story from a long time ago, usually about unreal things; often used to explain real events.
Modern	<b>Modern</b> is something that is happening now.
ancient	<b>Ancient</b> are things that happened a very long time ago.
economic	<b>Economic</b> history is about how groups of people have made and shared goods, services and wealth in the past.
social	<b>Social</b> history is how groups of people have lived and worked together in the past.
political	<b>Political</b> history is how groups of people have been ruled and organised in the past.
document	A <b>document</b> is written or printed information which proves something.
illustration	An <b>illustration</b> is a picture or diagram that helps to explain something.
perspective	<b>Perspective</b> is to see things in relation to other things.
reliable	<b>Reliable</b> is information and facts that can be taken as true.
reform	<b>Reform</b> is to change something for the better.
research	<b>Research</b> is to look for and find out facts and information.
anachronism	An <b>anachronism</b> is anything out of its proper time in history.
