### Basic history words

regime	A <b>regime</b> is a group of people who rule a country.
dictator	A <b>dictator</b> is a ruler with total power, especially one who has taken control by force.
Gestapo	The <b>Gestapo</b> are the German secret police.
Luftwaffe	The <b>Luftwaffe</b> was the German air force.
Nazi	A <b>Nazi</b> is a person who follows the ideas of the <b>Nazi</b> Party, led by Hitler, and having the belief that Germany should rule the world.
communism	<b>Communism</b> , is a belief in the sharing of work, wealth and property by all the community.
fascism	<b>Fascism</b> , is the strict control of a country, often by force, where there are few human rights and loyalty to the nation is demanded.
propaganda	<b>Propaganda</b> is the spreading of ideas and information, which only gives the governments side of things.
treaty	A <b>treaty</b> is an agreement between nations.
inflation	<b>Inflation</b> is when there is a rise in prices.
ration	A <b>ration</b> is a fixed share of food or clothing allowed to a person in a time of shortage.
blitz	The <b>Blitz</b> , was nightly, heavy bombing attacks on cities.
evacuee	An <b>evacuee</b> was someone who was moved to a safer place during wartime.
anti-Semitism	<b>Anti-Semitism</b> was the bad treatment or dislike of Jews.
conscription	<b>Conscription</b> , is to make someone join the armed forces.
