Topic Vocabulary

poetry	Technique whereby the phrasing of one line of poetry runs into the next line, because there is no punctuation at the end of the line.
culture	Liverpool is a city of culture .
stanza	The poem changes focus in the third stanza .
dialect	The Lancashire dialect seemed like a foreign language.
connotation	'connotation' - connected idea or association that is brought to mind b a word, based on how the word is often used.
denotation	A denotation is the literal or primary meaning of a word.
technique	We all admired the wood-carver's technique .
figurative	Figurative art is often defined in contrast to abstract art.
language	The TV censor cut out the bad language .
analyse	Can you analyse these results for me?
enjambment	A line having no end punctuation but running over to the next line.
hyperbole	An exaggeration for effect.
onomatopoeia	A word formed from a sound associated with what is named (e.g. pop, bang).
