dig	<b>dig</b> - dug - dug
do	<b>do</b> - did - done
draw	<b>draw</b> - drew - drawn
dream	<b>dream</b> - dreamt - dreamt
drink	<b>drink</b> - drank - drunk
drive	<b>drive</b> - drove - driven
eat	<b>eat</b> - ate - eaten
