

Spelling list: Irregular Verbs: Past Simple Form (g and h words)

Irregular verbs in English, beginning with the letters g and h. Learn the verbs in their past simple form in column one. See the verbs used in context in column two.

got	Last week, I got a good mark in my spelling test. (get - got - got)
gave	Last week, my mum gave me a bar of chocolate. (give - gave - given)
went	I went to the park last week. (go - went - gone)
grew	Last year, I grew my own tomatoes. (grow - grew - grown)
had	I had two cups of tea yesterday. (have - had - had)
heard	I heard the news yesterday. (hear - heard - heard)
hung	I hung the washing out yesterday afternoon. (hang - hung - hung)
hanged	They hanged the prisoner last week. (hang - hanged - hanged)
hid	Last week, my sister hid her toys from me. (hide - hid - hidden)
hit	She hit her head last week. (hit - hit - hit)
held	I held my newborn baby sister yesterday. (hold - held - held)
hurt	I hurt my knee yesterday. (hurt - hurt - hurt)
