got	Last week, I <b>got</b> a good mark in my spelling test. (get - <b>got</b> - got)
gave	Last week, my mum <b>gave</b> me a bar of chocolate. (give - <b>gave</b> - given)
went	I <b>went</b> to the park last week. (go - <b>went</b> - gone)
grew	Last year, I <b>grew</b> my own tomatoes. (grow - <b>grew</b> - grown)
had	I <b>had</b> two cups of tea yesterday. (have - <b>had</b> - had)
heard	I <b>heard</b> the news yesterday. (hear - <b>heard</b> - heard)
hung	I <b>hung</b> the washing out yesterday afternoon. (hang - <b>hung</b> - hung)
hanged	They <b>hanged</b> the prisoner last week. (hang - <b>hanged</b> - hanged)
hid	Last week, my sister <b>hid</b> her toys from me. (hide - <b>hid</b> - hidden)
hit	She <b>hit</b> her head last week. (hit - <b>hit</b> - hit)
held	I <b>held</b> my newborn baby sister yesterday. (hold - <b>held</b> - held)
hurt	I <b>hurt</b> my knee yesterday. (hurt - <b>hurt</b> - hurt)
