

Spelling list: Irregular Verbs: Past Simple Form (t and u words)

Irregular verbs in English, beginning with the letters t and u. Learn the verbs in their past simple form in column one. See the verbs used in context in column two.

took	I took some time off work last year. (take - took - taken)
taught	The teacher taught them fractions in Maths last week. (teach - taught - taught)
tore	Yesterday, he tore his trousers. (tear - tore - torn)
told	Yesterday, the teacher told the class a story. (tell - told - told)
thought	Yesterday, we thought about going on holiday. (think - thought - thought)
threw	Last summer, she threw the javelin. (throw - threw - thrown)
trod	Yesterday, she trod on her sister's foot! (tread - trod - trodden)
understood	I understood yesterday's lesson perfectly. (understand - understood - understood)
