Irregular verbs in English, beginning with the letters t and u. Learn the verbs in their past simple form in column one. See the verbs used in context in column two.

took	I <b>took</b> some time off work last year. (take - <b>took</b> - taken)
taught	The teacher <b>taught</b> them fractions in Maths last week. (teach - <b>taught</b> - taught)
tore	Yesterday, he <b>tore</b> his trousers. (tear - <b>tore</b> - torn)
told	Yesterday, the teacher <b>told</b> the class a story. (tell - <b>told</b> - told)
thought	Yesterday, we <b>thought</b> about going on holiday. (think - <b>thought</b> - thought)
threw	Last summer, she <b>threw</b> the javelin. (throw - <b>threw</b> - thrown)
trod	Yesterday, she <b>trod</b> on her sister's foot! (tread - <b>trod</b> - trodden)
understood	I <b>understood</b> yesterday's lesson perfectly. (understand - <b>understood</b> - understood)
