ridden I have never **ridden** my bike to school. (ride - rode - **ridden** )

rung So far this week, I have **rung** my friend three times. (ring - rang - **rung** )

risen The sun has just **risen** . (rise - rose - **risen** )

run I have never **run** the 100m race. (run - ran - **run** )
