

## Spelling list: Irregular Verbs: Past Participle Form (p, q, and r words)

Irregular verbs in English, beginning with the letters p, q, and r. Learn the verbs in their past participle form in column one. See the verbs used in context in column two.

paid	We have already <b>paid</b> for the shopping in cash. (pay - paid - <b>paid</b> )
put	I have always <b>put</b> my uniform away straight after school. (put - put - <b>put</b> )
quit	I have just <b>quit</b> my job. (quit - quit - <b>quit</b> )
read	So far in English, we have <b>read</b> three plays. (read - read - <b>read</b> )
ridden	I have never <b>ridden</b> my bike to school. (ride - rode - <b>ridden</b> )
rung	So far this week, I have <b>rung</b> my friend three times. (ring - rang - <b>rung</b> )
risen	The sun has just <b>risen</b> . (rise - rose - <b>risen</b> )
run	I have never <b>run</b> the 100m race. (run - ran - <b>run</b> )
